OCS ROLL-OFFS

Certain materials are banned from landfills for many different reasons. The obvious reason is the toxicity of the material. Hazardous and toxic wastes require special disposal methods to prevent environmental damage. Some materials may not be toxic, but are prohibited due to handling problems. Recyclable items are prohibited to encourage recycling and preservation of raw materials. Many area counties have a zero tolerance for cardboard in trash loads. This material will need to be disposed of separately.

PROHIBITED!

Tires

Batteries

Asbestos

Propane Tanks

Fluorescent tubes

Herbicides/Pesticides

Paint & Thinners (Dry Cans Only)

Liquids / Solvents / Freon or Chemicals

Biohazard materials or Medical Waste

Equipment containing gas or oil including oil rags

White Goods (refrigerators, stoves, etc)

Concrete must be placed in a separate container

Note: Local government may enforce these prohibitions with stiff fines and penalties which are the responsibility of the customer. Alternative disposal methods that include recycling will safeguard the environment. Compliance with state and local regulations is not difficult however, special handling or separation of materials is necessary for lawful disposal of these materials.
